Dear Friend of Mohawk & NIACC Baseball,

Mason City Mohawks Baseball Stadium at Roosevelt Field needs your help!

Built in 1938, the 70 year-old Mohawk Baseball Stadium at Roosevelt Field is in dire need of renovation/repair due to disintegrating cement structure, fiberglass bleachers that have crumbled beyond repair and need total replacement, sandblasting of entire stadium due to paint flaking off and rust development, painting of entire stadium and enlargement of press box. This needed renovation would improve the enjoyment of all that attend baseball games not only for this season, but for future generations of Mohawk baseball players and the fans. This entire project is being done without the use of any School District funds or any funds from the Mohawk Booster Club. All money raised for this project will be from donations secured from an all-volunteer work force through a letter-writing campaign to potential donors, businesses and grants written to local charitable foundations. Our goal is to have an anticipated completion date of project: May 4, 2008-In time for NIACC hosting the Regional Tournament at the Mohawk Baseball Stadium. **If you are willing to contribute, we need your donation by March 1, 2008.** There is a space on the donation pledge card if you wish your gift to remain anonymous.

As a friend of Mason City Mohawk baseball, and Mason City High School alumni, please consider a donation for the needed renovation of this grand 70 year-old Mason City Mohawk Baseball Stadium. Scope of Mohawk Baseball Stadium Project & Costs:

1. Patch & repair disintegrating mortar between original cement blocks, sand blast & paint entire stadium (Stadium only)	\$42,500.00
Paint original light towers (Paint only)	\$12,500.00
New bleachers to replace original fiberglass bleachers that are disintegrating.	\$34,500.00
4. Installation costs for new bleachers	\$11,000.00

Press Box Costs:

5. Enlarging press box, repair, and paint	\$16,600.00
TOTAL COSTS for COMPLETE RENOVATION/REPAIR:	\$117,100.00
